

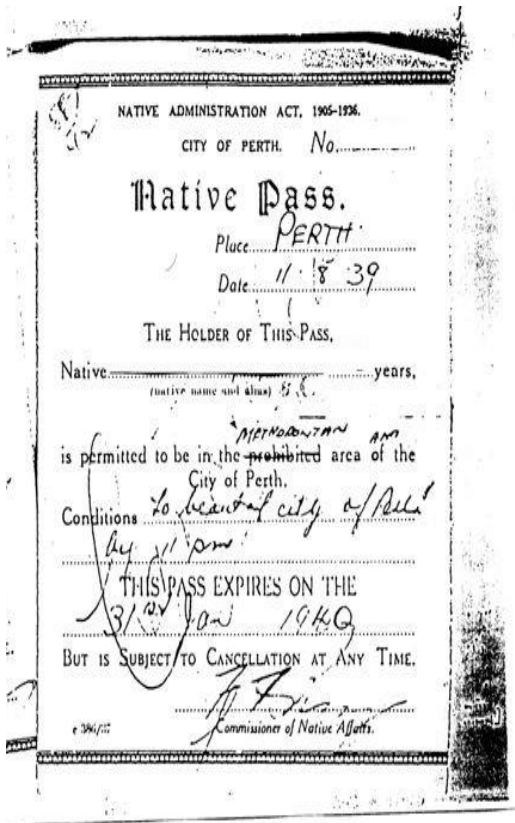


Resource 4 - Study these Primary Sources from the Exhibition to better understand the lack of democratic rights for Whadjuk peoples.

Background - The Aborigines Act of 1905 & the position of AO Neville as Chief Protector of Aborigines in 1916, saw strict controls put in place over all aspects of the lives of Aboriginal people. This initiated the White Australia policy and included segregation and the idea of 'breeding' out of Aboriginality which led to policy of children being removed from their families - Stolen generations.

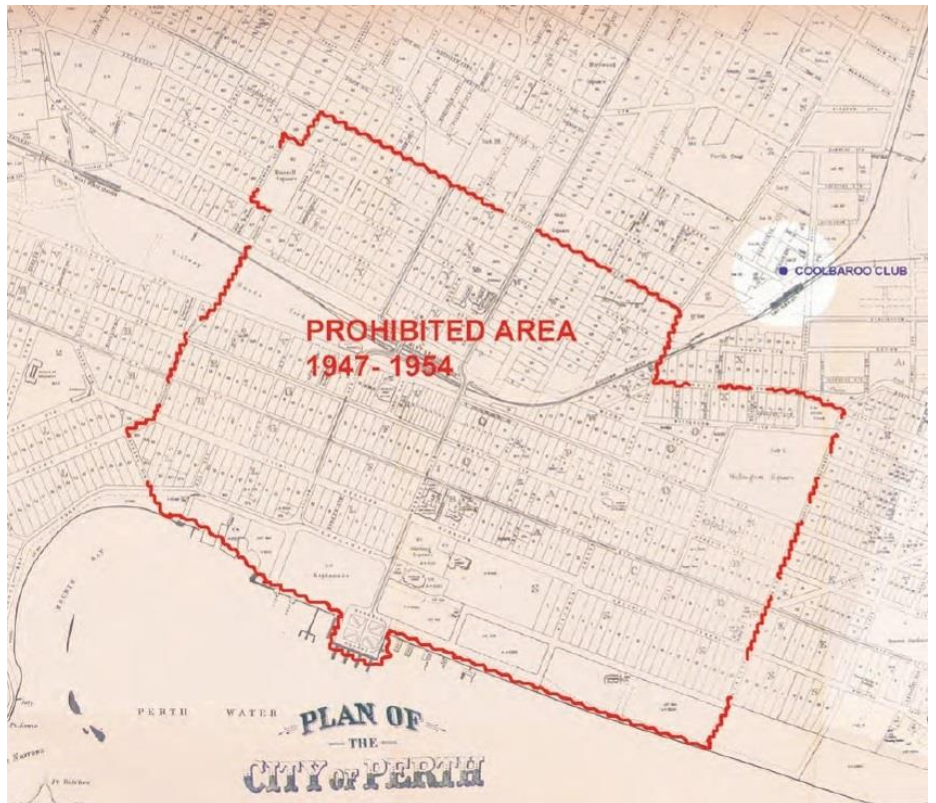
